Description of the Master of Arts/Christian Ministries Degree

The Master of Arts/Christian Ministries degree is designed to equip students for service as a minister of education, minister to youth, minister to children, administrator in the local church, a missionary in the area of Christian education, or a teacher or administrator in a church-related school. This degree requires 60 semester hours of academic credit for graduation.

Completion Requirements for the Master of Arts/Christian Ministries Degree General Requirements

In order to qualify for graduation from Mid-America Seminary or College, each student seeking the Master of Arts/Christian ministries degree must satisfy the General Requirements for Graduation as set forth in this catalog.

Course Requirements

Each student pursuing the Master of Arts/Christian ministries degree must complete the 60 semester hours of courses specified in the following chart, including 54 semester hours of required courses and six elective hours. Note: Logos Bible Research Software (Silver edition or above) is recommended for courses in the New Testament Department.
